product preserved by a different method. Jar labels must list type of product and process used (i.e. apricot jam, pectin method; frozen green beans, blanched one minute, and to be used within three months.)

NOTE: Entry form must list type of product (fruit, vegetable, etc.) and the method or process used (canning or drying). Low acid foods must be canned under pressure. No paraffin seals. Canning exhibits must be in sealed jars. Dried products must be wrapped in clear plastic or in sealed jars.

JUNIOR TABLE SETTING

1. The EXHIBITOR must set up table setting.
2. Tables will be provided by fair. Exhibitor must provide all other materials.
3. Centerpiece must be made by exhibitor and may not be pre-made centerpiece from a store. Centerpiece should be as creative as possible and use color.
4. Menu will be judged and must be printed on a 3X5 card or in other attractive, legible manner, and must include at least one item from each food group to balance the menu.
5. Entry must include one place setting, centerpiece, and menu. Entry must fit on 24" X 24" space.
6. No waxed candles are to be used. Suggest plastic or ceramic.

JUNIOR PHOTOGRAPHY

USE SEPARATE ENTRY FORM

SPECIAL RULES:

1. Limit 2 entries per class. Total of 4 pictures.
2. Picture taken within one year of fair date.
3. Must be mounted and ready to hang.
4. Prints must be framed, covered with glass and be wired for hanging. (Screw eyes in frame with wire only. No saw-toothed hangers, fishing line or poster frames.) Pictures not suitable for hanging will be rejected. The size of the print shall be no less than 5 x 7 and no greater than 16 x 20.
5. Exhibitor's name and address and the title of the print, division & class must appear on the back of the mount. .
6. List each print separately on one entry form. Include title of each print on entry form.
7. Public will not be allowed in judging area.

5. **DIMENSIONS:** Mounted-maximum 16" X 20", Minimum 9" X 12". Framed-maximum 20" X 24", Minimum 9" X 12".
