2. Animal must be conditioned, fitted and trained to show with lead or collar.
3. Outfit must be made of cotton or 70% cotton blend.
4. Entrant will be judged on mode of attire selected, which must be attractive and lend elegance to the class. (THIS IS NOT A COSTUME CLASS)
5. No open toed shoes.

NOTE: Dairy animals to be sold in replacement project must remain on Fairgrounds during fair and maintained by exhibitor.

1. All Dairy animals over four months of age must bear evidence of official calf-hood vaccination against brucellosis.
2. Have a permanent ear tag or tattoo number.
3. All animals must have been owned for up to 18 months prior to fair. Registration Certificate or Bill of Sale showing date of birth and sire of animal entered will be required as proof of ownership for all animals entered in this division.
4. Animals in this division cannot be shown in any other Class **except** part of a pair's class, showmanship, or chapter group
5. All Sale Heifers must be bred by Feb 1, 2010 with proof of pregnancy by Licensed Veterinarian turned in with Entry Form.
6. Brand Inspection Papers must be presented to Livestock Office on Thursday, October 14, 2010.

DIVISION 431 REGISTERED-PUREBRED DAIRY CATTLE

Senior and Junior yearlings in milk must be shown with two year olds. NOTE: "In Milk" on Entry Form.

Bill of Sale showing date of birth and sire of animal entered will be required as proof of ownership for all animals entered in this division.

1. By his/her signature as owner on an entry form the exhibitor certifies that the sire of each animal entered in the following division for grade animals was registered.
