Check-in: 9:30 p.m.

Competition begins: 10:00 a.m. sharp

There will be a qualified obedience judge, a qualified showmanship judge, a Rally judge, and a proctor handling the written tests. Be ready for competition at 9am.

Entry fee: \$10.00 for the 1st dog, \$4.00 for each additional dog.

The first entry fee includes an obedience class, showmanship class, rally and the written test. Each additional dog with the same handler may enter agility and obedience.

Show Rules

1. The exhibitor must work, groom, and show his/her own dog. No other person may handle the dog during the show.
2. No dog may be left unattended. Members are responsible for cleaning after their dog.
3. Dogs must be at least 5 months old to enter the show.
4. No hard corrections allowed.
5. Exhibitor will lose points in showmanship if 4-H uniform is not worn.
6. Members may not show in obedience levels which are below the highest level they have previously shown in. For example, if you have shown your dog in the Novice class at another show you cannot show in Novice Y at this show.
7. Entry forms must be signed by the project leader to verify that the member is enrolled in a 4-H Dog Project, and the dog is current for DHL-Rabies.
8. Written test questions are taken from the 4-H Care of a Dog booklet and general dog breed information.
9. Rally is offered as a learning experience and as a fun class. All entrants will be judged equally in this class with one set of awards given.

Obedience Levels:

Puppy Obedience – for members with dogs which are 5-9 months. Puppies may do as much as they have learned.

Mini-member – for mini members age 5 to 8 years.

Pre-Novice – for members and dogs who have never shown in an obedience class.

Exercises are all on leash: - heel - recall - stand for examination
- 1 minute long sit - figure 8 - 3 minute long down

Novice Y – for members who have shown in an Obedience class before but are not ready to show off-leash. Exercises are the same as Pre-novice.

Novice – for members who are ready to show off-leash, or have shown before in novice Obedience.

Exercises are: - 1 minute sit off leash - stand - heeling on/off leash
- 3 minute down off leash - recall

Graduate Novice – for members who have mastered the Novice class or have shown in Graduate

Novice before. Exercises are: -heel of/off leash - 3 minute sit - drop on recall
- stand/figure 8 off leash - 5 minute down with handler not in sight

Rally - a type of obedience class. The dog and handler follow 18-20 numbered signs having simple directions such as turn right, halt, down your dog, etc. The judge will provide directions and allow members to walk the course before the competition. Only beginning Rally, following AKC rules, will be offered. Please bring a collar and lead for this class, chains are not used.
