SPECIAL RULES:

1. Each judging is limited to a total of 20 tables. Entries are accepted on a first-come basis. All entries received after judging is filled will be on a "stand-by" basis and notified if an entered exhibitor cancels or fails to compete at the scheduled time, the open tables may be filled with "stand-by" exhibitors. 2. Tables 3' X 5' will be furnished by the management. We recommend two to four settings except where stated. Linen, china, glassware, and flatware to be furnished by the exhibitor. Exhibitor to cover entire table with linen or suitable covering to allow six inch drop on all sides. The management will take every precaution to assure safe return of these items; however, management will assume no responsibility, for loss or damage.
3. No cut fruit, vegetables or perishable food is allowed. (This includes vegetables or bread items that have been preserved with sealer)
4. Use taper candles with discretion. In warm weather, the temperature in the exhibits tent has been known to cause these candles to droop or melt.
5. Each exhibitor shall provide a box or carton with the exhibitor's name clearly marked to remain at the exhibit site while entry is in place. During the three hour period when exhibits are released and accepted between divisions, management reserves the right to remove items and transfer them to boxes provided by exhibitor to assure a smooth transition between judgings.
6. Emphasis should be on originality and over-all design.
7. Tables will be judged from all angles.

8. Entries may not have previously been entered in Southern California Fair.
