Entry Fee: \$3.00 per class

SPECIAL RULES:

- All entries must have been produced by the exhibitor within the last year and not entered at a previous Southern California Fair.
- Paintings and drawings must be labeled on the back with the exhibitor's name, address, telephone and title of picture.
- All exhibits must be prepared with eye-screws and wires. No saw tooth hangers please.**
- DIMENSIONS** -due to display panel size the maximum "FRAMED" width of 48" length of 36", will be accepted.
- Copies or reproduction of the artists' work will not be accepted for competition, except in the division for reproductions.
- The management may rescind the right of hanging or displaying any work deemed unsuitable.
- Entries not picked up by exhibitor on Monday, Oct. 17th will become property of the Southern California Fair.
