SPECIAL RULES:

Limit: one entry per class.

1. Use of flowers and fresh material should be worked into arrangements as much as possible. It is not required that the exhibitors in these divisions grow their own flowers.
2. Exhibitors in these divisions must have all entries in place by the hour designated in each division. Entries may not be removed prior to time designated for each division.
3. Foliage and accessories are permitted. Artificial flowers and foliage may not be used unless specified in class.
4. Exhibitors are requested to leave correct name of any unusual plant material used with superintendent.
5. The management reserves the right to place or group all entries according to available space.
6. The management reserves the right to decline entries, if insufficient display space is available or if entry is of inferior quality, or unsuitable.
7. After judging, the management reserves the right to remove, freshen or replace any exhibit.
8. During judging exhibitors will NOT be permitted in the immediate vicinity.

9. Entries not picked up by 4:00 pm Oct. 17th, will become property of the Southern California Fair.

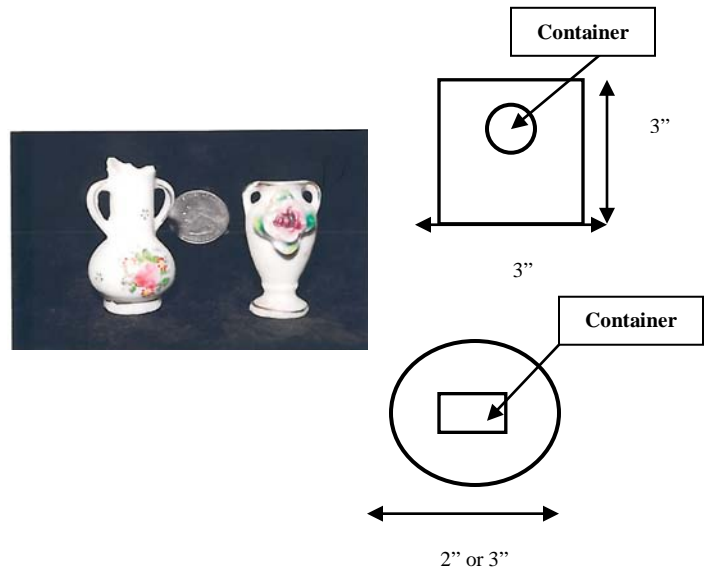
