### Special Rules:

1. This judging is limited to 16 entries. Entries are accepted on a first come basis.
2. Exhibitor to decorate an artificial tree furnished by exhibitor. Artificial tree to be no taller than 3 feet 6 inches, including stand. Stand to be covered by exhibitor. Any type of artificial tree that is suitable to the class may be used.
3. **No electric lights** may be used in the decoration, in accordance with fire regulations.
4. Trees will be judged from all sides.
5. No cut vegetables, fruit, or perishable food is allowed. (This includes perishables that have been preserved with a sealer)
6. Exhibitor to decorate tree in theme that reflects the class with ornaments, foliage, fabric, or other suitable decorative materials. The management will take every precaution to assure safe return of these items; however management will assume no responsibility for loss or damage.

4. All other rules pertaining to the Fine Arts Department pertain.

## DIVISION 49 DIGITALLY ALTERED PHOTOGRAPHY

Rules:

1. Any two-dimensional image, which originated from a camera but can include images & pictures from any and all sources and then manipulated in a computer.

CLASS

- 1 **KRAZY PICTURES:** A combination of multiple images of any number in a final manipulated resulting image. Image must be suitable for hanging (framed with a hanging wire securely fastened to the frame) and include a printed 3X5 card stating all the different image sources used and techniques involved. All items in this class will be hung together with the title **"GUESS THE TOTAL NUMBER OF DIFFERENT IMAGES IN THE PICTURE!"** Maximum picture size is 16X20.
- 2 **Before and After**  
Show off your creativity and technical ability. Enter two boards with images neatly mounted on white or black board.  
Board #1=the original un-manipulated photographic image.  
Board #2=the final manipulated resulting image. On the back of the board include a brief description of methods used to achieve final result.
