SPECIAL RULES:

The Southern California Fair is a member of the American Poultry Association, and the show will be governed by the rules of that organization and by California State Fair rules.

1. All exhibitors are entered and shown at the owners' risk. Southern California Fair is not responsible for loss or accident due to theft or destruction. Every precaution will be taken to eliminate danger and mistakes in the handling of the stock.
2. **Limit of Entries:** There is no limit to entries, however, please be reminded that rule IV-6 of the California State Rules applies.
3. Exhibitors will not be notified of the acceptance of entries. Entries must be made online.
4. CDFA & STATE Health Rules will be strictly enforced. All poultry will be inspected at the designated poultry inspection area. Absolutely NO poultry will be allowed on the fairgrounds without passing inspection. **If birds are brought on grounds without being inspected they will be disqualified and must leave the premises.** All birds must be numbered with LEGIBLE NUMBERED BANDS prior to inspection at the fair. The number of this band MUST be the same as shown on the entry form. Duplicate numbers must not be used on birds of the same variety. Numbered bands are available in most feed stores. The tape will not be permitted. Birds will be inspected one time per exhibitor.
5. Any/All eggs laid during the fair will become the property of the Southern California Fair.
6. Releases must be obtained from the poultry department before birds will be released. Birds not picked up by 10:00 p.m. on the release date will become the property of the Southern California Fair unless other arrangements have been made with the superintendent.
7. Exhibitors desiring to sell birds are responsible for their own sales. No sales will be handled by fair personnel. **NO "For Sale" SIGNS WILL BE ALLOWED ON CAGES AT ANY TIME.**
8. All birds will be shown in suitable coops. The right is reserved to coop double, females of the same variety, owned by one exhibitor.
9. Judging shall be by comparison and in accordance with the latest published standards. Decisions of the judge shall be final. EXHIBITORS OR THEIR AGENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO CONVERSE WITH THE JUDGES WHILE JUDGING IS IN PROGRESS.
10. Birds substituted must be the same breed, variety, age, and sex as the original entry.
11. All crates must be removed from the showroom as soon as birds are transferred to show coops.
12. **Exhibitors are required to provide their own feed and water dishes. Feed will Not be provided.**

Poultry showing signs of aggression towards judges & public will not be judged.

Small Animal Master Showmanship

Only the highest placing in county exhibitor will advance to master showmanship.

The 1st place winner of each of the classes will be given the opportunity to compete in the Small Animal Master Showmanship Contest. Each Specie contest winner must declare to the Livestock Office his or her intention for the competition. If their intentions are not declared, the Livestock Office will offer the next-placed specie contestant the opportunity to compete in the Small Animal Master Showmanship Contest.

COUNTY FAIR BEST OF SHOW MASTER SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

This special competition is open to exhibitors winning the senior-level Master Showmanship or Senior Round Robin Showmanship in large animal competitions (beef, sheep, swine, dairy cattle, market goats, horse or dairy goats.) Or in small animal competitions (poultry, rabbit, dog, pygmy goat, and cavy) at their County, District, or Citrus Fair, between July 1, 2022, and June 30, 2023. Classes are offered in Large Animal Livestock Showmanship and in Small Animal Showmanship. Large Animal Master Showmanship Show Day - July 17, 2023, Small Animal Master Showmanship Show Day - July 21, 2023, Refer to County Fair Best of Show Competition Guide for complete rules.
